An unprecedented exhibition exploring the broad spectrum of contemporary African art, design, and craft worldwide. Featuring the work of over 60 artists, *The Global Africa Project* surveys the rich pool of new talent emerging from the African continent and its influence on artists around the world. Through ceramics, basketry, textiles, jewelry, furniture, and fashion, as well as selective examples of architecture, photography, painting, and sculpture, the exhibition challenges conventional notions of a singular African aesthetic or identity, and reflects the integration of African art and design without making the usual distinctions between “professional” and “artisan.”

A guided tour of Laumont Editions Gallery: a leading source of contemporary digital photography. Many influential artists have turned to new digital techniques to produce works of great quality and originality. In the last 12 years the studio has produced editions with Ross Bleckner, Cecily Brown, James Casebere, Nan Goldin, Dan Graham, Peter Halley, Roni Horn, Vik Muniz, Jack Pierson, Richard Prince, Andres Serrano, Stephen Shore, Lorna Simpson, Andrew Wyeth among others.
